Repatriation from sanctioned country

As a result of a DFAT alert a request was received to assist with the repatriation of a dual national staff member from a sanctioned country. GI24 confirmed the individual was at risk. It was assumed that any communication with the individual would be monitored so a pretext was created to bring the individual back to Australia without disclosing the DFAT advisory. In order not to draw attention a return ticket was procured with a stated intent of allowing the individual to return. The individual was allowed to depart and safely returned to Australia. Upon arrival the individual was briefed on the actual situation and whilst initially upset with the deception accepted the reasons for the repatriation.
